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
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Opening Words

This year, we celebrate the 41th edition of the International Young Audience Film Festival Ale Kino!, as well as the 60th anniversary of Poznań's cinematic events dedicated to children and younger viewers. Ale Kino! has continued the tradition established in 1963 by the Animated Film Review, and thus is the second oldest Polish film festival and the second oldest film festival for young audiences in the world.

We celebrate the 60th anniversary during the 41th edition of the event, because there were times when the Festival took place every two years. During that period, the event changed its name several times, and the current one – International Young Audience Film Festival Ale Kino! – is... the eighth one! This proves that change is rooted in the nature of the Festival and is a direct result of actively responding to the requirements of the changing reality. The Festival's programme has always included films that address topics that are close to children and teenagers, tackle important social issues, and present diverse experiences of young people from different parts of the world. These works also possess high artistic quality and represent a variety of genres as well as forms. It will be no different this year.

The milestone anniversary is a symbolic turning point, which can also be seen as a unique meeting of the past, present, and future: we remember our history and look forward with courage. This meeting takes place in our here and now, which is the only time we have a real influence on; and it is also now that we reminisce about the Festival while preparing its archive (as part of the Children's Art Centre archive, which is currently being created) and thinking about its future shape.

That is why I would like to thank the whole team, who has worked on the 41thedition of Ale Kino! throughout the year – from raising funds for the event, through producing and coordinating the work, creating

Dear Viewers and Guests,

I always see creating the festival programme as a fascinating journey through the vast land of young audience cinema. It was no different this year. The richness and diversity of the submitted films – both the shorts and the features, the ones for the children and the ones for the youth – were fascinating. We have dealt with many genres, different cinematic languages, as well as multifaceted messages giving unique perspectives on reality, society, and culture.

These films have reflected our difficult and extraordinary times like a mirror, but also told universal stories, probably understandable to everyone across the globe. They have presented captivating portraits of young people, often struggling with the surrounding world, fighting for their dignity, freedom, the right to love and be loved, a good family, a friendly school. They have shown both extremely difficult issues and wonderful joys of life; they have brought hope. We have seen works from countries that are leaders of the European and world cinema, as well as places with perhaps less potential, but equally great abilities. We have enjoyed films from near and far, from the Czech Republic, Germany, Bosnia, but also from Argentina or Mongolia.

These are just examples; the Festival program will cover over 30 countries, including Poland. We kept observing new domestic productions and co-productions with a particular interest. After the initial selection, we had a total of about 500 full- and short-length films in front of us, from which we carefully put together the Festival repertoire. This year, the choice was especially difficult, mainly because the quality of these five hundred works was very high. I assure you that the viewers of Ale Kino! will see films that are, in our opinion, the best, most interesting and most important ones. I also hope that many of these which sadly had to be left out of the not-so-extendable Festival programme will be made available to Polish film lovers a little bit later, in cinemas or streaming services.

The Ale Kino! Festival celebrates its 60th anniversary this year. No matter the phase of its development, it has always been an event for which two elements were vital: choosing good films and gathering the viewers. This year, we have done our best to do the same. I am convinced that we have succeeded, but it will be best if you – children, teenagers, and adults – confirm it yourself.

WIKTOR SZYMURSKI





Platynowe Koziołki to nagroda organizatorów Międzynarodowego Festiwalu Filmów Młodego Widza Ale Kino! przyznawana od 2002 r. Są nią wyróżniane wybitne osiągnięcia w dziedzinie filmu bądź mediów dla dzieci. Pierwszą laureatką nagrody była Maria Kaniewska, a następnie: Stanisław Jędryka (2003), Andrzej Maleszka (2004), Hanna Polak i Andrzej Celiński (2005), Dorota Kędzierzawska (2006), Wytwórnia Filmów Animowanych Se-Ma-For (2007), Witold Giersz (2008), projekt Polskiego Instytutu Sztuki Filmowej - Filmoteka Szkolna (2009), TV Studio Filmów Animowanych w Poznaniu, film "Magiczne drzewo" w reżyserii Andrzeja Maleszki oraz Václav Vorlíček (2010), Jiří Menzel, film "Historia żółtej ciżemki" w reżyserii Sylwestra Chęcińskiego oraz Co Hoedeman (2011), Andrzej Wajda oraz Tadeusz Wilkosz (2012), Bolek i Lolek (2013), Krzysztof Gradowski (2014), Zofia Ołdak, Paul Driessen oraz Jerzy Armata (2015), Jacek Adamczak i Rock Demers (2016), piesek Reksio (2017), Dział Edukacji Stowarzyszenia Nowe Horyzonty (2018). W 2019 r. nagrodę przyznano Koziołkowi Matołkowi, bohaterowi zrodzonemu w książkach obrazkowych Kornela Makuszyńskiego i Mariana Walentynowicza. W 2020 r. statuetkę otrzymała firma producencka BosBros, a w ubiegłym roku – studio Animoon oraz Felix Vanginderhuysen.

Platinum Goats: Jerzy Łukaszewicz

Although he is a cinematographer by profession, Jerzy Łukaszewicz successfully practices directing as well. He quickly developed his distinctive character of film writing, and is primarily interested in adventure cinema aimed at young viewers. He made his debut with the spectacular Przyjaciel wesołego diabła (Friend of the Jolly Devil, 1986), an adaptation of Kornel Makuszyński's novel dealing with the eternal theme of the struggle between good and evil. On the border of the Land of Darkness lives a sage named Witalis, who guards the Land of Light from the temptations of dark forces. The old man takes care of an abandoned baby, who grows up to become a wise and handsome boy. He will have to go to the Land of Darkness to fight its ruler. If he wins, his guardian will regain his sight. In his adventure, he is accompanied by the eponymous, cheerful little devil, Piszczałka. It is worth noting that the scenography of this captivating story was created by Piotr Dumała, an excellent director of animated films. Łukaszewicz used the footage filmed to prepare a TV series version of the story two years later (1988), and the characters quickly returned to the cinemas in Bliskie spotkania z wesołym diablem (Close Encounters with the Jolly Devil, 1988).

In his subsequent productions – the feature film Łowca. Ostatnie starcie (The Hunter. Final Scuffle, 1993), as well as the TV series Wow (1993), Tajemnica Sagali (The Secret of Sagala, 1996), Gwiezdny pirat (Star Pirate, 1998), and Słoneczna włócznia (Spear of the Sun, 2000) – Łukaszewicz remained faithful to the theme of the conflict between good and evil, often presenting it in a form of a fairy tale, sometimes resembling the real world, but sometimes closer to virtual reality.

Łukaszewicz's films have been showered with awards in Poznań: Waldemar Pokromski and Stanisław Lenartowicz were acknowl-

edged for their special effects in *Przyjaciel wesołego diabła* (1988), Rafał Synówka for his child role in *Bliskie spotkania z wesołym diabłem* (1990), Michał Lorenc and Zdzisław Najda for music and cinematography in Łowca. Ostatnie starcie (1994), Krzesimir Dębski, Zdzisław Najda (again) and Grzegorz Ruda for music, cinematography and acting in *Tajemnica Sagali* (1997), Krzesimir Dębski (again) and Zbigniew Hałat for music and cinematography in *Gwiezdny pirat* (1998). Łukaszewicz himself has been awarded five times so far: Silver Goats for cinematography in *Muchołap* (*Fly Catcher*, 1977) by Jadwiga Kędzierzawska, Poznań Goats for the best feature film *Przyjaciel wesołego diabła* (1988), Special Award and Marcinek for *Bliskie spotkania z wesołym diabłem* (1990) and another Marcinek award for *Gwiezdny pirat* (1998). So, it's time to honour him with the Platinum Goats!

Platinum Goats: Krzysztof Kiwerski

Krzysztof Kiwerski is a leading director of the excellent and, unfortunately, no longer existing Animated Film Studio in Kraków, which in the 1970's worked on creating a new cinematic formula for the youngest viewers. The Krakowian artists did not want to make films that would be just another series of similar adventures of the same characters, but authorial works, which would attempt to stimulate children's imagination, sensitivity, and intelligence. Animations by Julian Józef Antonisz, his younger brother Ryszard Antoniszczak, Łucja Mróz, Paweł Nowosławski, and Kiwerski himself – often acclaimed and awarded in Poznań – turned out to be the best examples of that approach.

Kiwerski's debut film – Awaria (Breakdown, 1975) – very well received by critics and festival jurors (Golden Seal of the City of Trieste, 1976; Golden Goats in Poznań, 1977; the Zenon Wasilewski Award, 1977) – was one of such authorial animations for children. In the following years, the director worked on films for the youngest audience twice more. They were both extremely successful productions, which brought him further wins at the Poznań festival: *UFO* (1978) was awarded with Golden Goats (1979), and *Jasio* (*Johnny*, 1979) with Silver Goats (1981). These three films, which were all honoured in Poznań, form a kind of an unofficial trifecta. They are all funny science fiction stories. Kiwerski made them according to a similar scheme. No words are spoken in any of them, the images sufficiently perform the entire narrative function, and the soundtrack, including mainly "cosmic" music by Marek Wilczyński, complements it perfectly.

Kiwerski returned to creating for the youngest viewers only in the nineties, but these were no longer short authorial animations, but more commercially oriented, full-length films: *Lisiczka* (1991, co-direction: Paweł Nowosławski), *Królestwo Zielonej Polany* (*The Kingdom of*



Green Glade, 1994), Miki Mol i Straszne Płaszczydło (Miki Moth and the Horrible Monstercoat, 1996, co-direction: Ryszard Antoniszczak), Królestwo Zielonej Polany. Powrót (The Kingdom of Green Glade – The Return, 1998, co-direction: Longin Szmyd) and episodes of the series Bajki zza okna (Fairy Tales from Behind the Window, 1994–1998, co-direction: Ryszard Antoniszczak).

Kiwerski makes art directed mainly at adults. The world he creates in films, paintings, and illustrations alike is terrifying and alarming. There are many threats in it, the most important being totalitarianism of any kind. Dark visions are balanced by means of humour and light-heartedness, but above all – by positive stories he makes for children. This is the brighter side of his work, for which – after the Golden and Silver Goats – he is awarded with the Platinum Goats. It is worth adding that this Krakow-based artist, who works closely with the TV Studio of Animated Films in Poznań, was actually born in Poznań.

The "People for People" Community Foundation



The Foundation was established in 1989. It deals with widely understood oncological problems, focusing on the prevention and early detection of cancer, combined with the promotion of a healthy lifestyle. The Foundation works towards this end by mass screenings, training courses for healthcare professionals, education of young people and adults, and publishing work. Another important area of focus is supporting people suffering from cancer and their families, and more specifically - offering practical, organisational and financial support to associations of oncology patients and their volunteers, providing physical and mental rehabilitation services after the treatment of malignant neoplasms, as well as offering education and counselling for cancer patients and their families (directly and through publications). Finally, the Foundation provides material aid to oncology facilities by supplying them with the necessary diagnostic and treatment equipment. In order to reach the widest possible audience, the Foundation combines health promotion and cancer prevention efforts with outdoor events such as local festivals, mass races for children, and cultural events. Most of the Foundation's initiatives take the form of monitored programmes rather than one-off events.

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Regulations of the Ale Kino! International Young Audience Film Festival

41. International Young Audience Film Festival

PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

- 1. The 41st Ale Kino! International Young Audience Film Festival (hereinafter referred to as the Festival) will be held in Poznań from November 26th to December 3rd, 2023.
- 2. The aim of the Festival is to present and promote valuable films for children and young people.

ORGANISATION

- 3. The Festival is organised by Centrum Sztuki Dziecka w Poznaniu (Children's Art Centre in Poznań, the Organiser).
- 4. The Festival Director is the director of the Children's Art Centre in Poznań, unless the director of the Children's Art Centre in Poznań or a superior authority designates another person.

PROGRAMME

5. The Festival programme comprises the following sections:

a. International Competition of full-length and short films for children and young people, featuring films made between 2021 and 2023. Full-length and short films (live-action, animations, documentaries) are eligible for the competition. Competition films will be evaluated in two categories: films for children and films for young people. The categories are assigned by the Organiser.

b. Fringe sections and special screenings, where out-of-competition films for children, young people and adults are presented.

SELECTION OF FILMS

- 6. The call for entries opens on March 1st, 2023.
- 7. Films may be entered by authorized persons: authors, producers or other.
- 8. Whether a film will be admitted to the Festival is decided by the Organiser.
- 9. Only films which have been entered within the specified time limit and in compliance with these Regulations are subject to selection for Festival screenings. Each entry must be accompanied by:

a. an entry form completed online (available on FilmFreeway).

b. a screener with the film in an English language version or with English subtitles.

10. The competition is open to films which meet the following criteria:a. are live-action, animated or documentary films, either full-length or short ones, made after January 1st, 2021. 'Full-length' should be understood as longer than 60 minutes. 'Short' should be understood as shorter than 30 minutes.

b. films are available as a DCP, digital files or other.

c. represent a separate artistic whole.

- The final deadline for submitting entry forms and materials for the competition section is July 31st, 2023.
- It is the Entrant's responsibility to obtain authorisation to use and enter the film in the Festival.
- The Organiser will notify all Entrants of the selection results as soon as the selection process is complete.

- c. Golden Goats to the best full-length film for young people;
- d. Golden Goats to the best short film for young people.
- 25. The children's jury shall award the Marcinek prizes to the best full-length and the best short film for children.
- 26. The young people's jury shall award the Marcin prizes to the best full-length and the best short film for young people.
- 27. The Festival audience shall award its prize to the best full-length film.
- The Festival Organiser shall award the special prize of Platinum Goats for excellent film or audiovisual media output aimed at young audiences.
- 29. Other special prizes funded by private individuals, institutions and organisations may also be awarded in agreement with the Organiser.

GUESTS

30. The Organiser invites selected authors of films qualified to the Festival, as well as excellent individuals, press members, distributors, producers and people connected with audiovisual culture for children and youth.

FINAL PROVISIONS

- By entering a film in the Festival and participating in the Festival the Entrant agrees to comply with these Regulations.
- 32. The Festival Organiser is not liable for any damage or loss resulting from the infringement of the rights of third parties that may arise in connection with the use of the submitted works, unless the infringement has been caused solely by the Organiser. The Entrant hereby indemnifies the Organiser from any liability in that respect.
- 33. In the event of doubt as to the interpretation of these Regulations, the Polish language version shall prevail.
- 34. Issues not covered by these Regulations are subject to decisions made by the Festival Director.

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
